## 2004 income guidelines for USDA youth, adult food program

The Elmendorf Family Members Program Flight, as well as the Denali, Sitka and Katmai Child Development Centers and the Ketchikan School-Age Program announce their participation in the U.S. Department of Agriculture Child and Adult Care Food Program.

The program is administered by the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development.

Meals are made available to enrolled children at no separate

charge without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability.

Parent's income determines the amount of money the USDA will reimburse Elmendorf to provide

meals to enrolled children.

The income eligibility guidelines listed below are used to determine Elmendorf's reimbursement from the USDA.

Children from households whose monthly income is at or below these levels are eligible to be counted for free or reduced-price meal reimbursement.
