Traveling with pets

For people PCSing to Europe, the regulations for animal importation to all countries of the European Union have changed. Pets now need to be microchipped with an ISO-compatible chip, which military veterinary clinics in Alaska already use. Also, a new bilingual health certificate must now be used and will need to be endorsed by a Federal U.S. Department of Agriculture veterinarian. This process will re-

quire advance planning.
